



Consumer Health & Food Safety Reviews



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Pima County Development Services

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□ How does the program work?

- Consumer Health & Food Safety (CHFS) plan review for Fixed Food Establishments, Ice and Bottling Plants, Mobile Home Parks, Hotels/Motels, and Public/Semi-Public Pools and Spas in all incorporated and unincorporated jurisdictions of the County shall be conducted by Development Services Department (DSD).
- CHFS applications for which a building permit is also sought, shall undergo a consolidated CHFS/building code review.
- CHFS inspections shall be completed by CHFS inspectors.

□ What items do I need for my submittal?

- Plans shall be prepared by an Arizona Registrant.
- Food establishment plans and specifications shall include but not be limited to the following information to demonstrate code conformance:
 - ◇ Architectural, mechanical, plumbing, and electrical drawings
 - ◇ Intended menu
 - ◇ Type of establishment and anticipated volume of food to be stored, prepared, and sold or served.
 - ◇ Proposed layout, mechanical schematics, construction materials, and finish schedules.
 - ◇ Proposed equipment layout and types, manufacturers, model numbers, locations, dimensions, and performance capacities (New and Existing).

- ◇ Standard procedures ensuring compliance.

□ How do I apply and pay for the review application?

- The owner or owner's agent shall submit application for the CHFS review at Pima County Development Services located at 201 N. Stone Avenue.
- All application fees shall be collected prior to conducting the review.
- Applicants shall provide the following information.
 - ◇ Owner's name
 - ◇ Project description
 - ◇ Business name
 - ◇ Project Address

□ Where do I pick up my approved review?

- When the CHFS review has been completed, the applicant shall be contacted to retrieve the application package from Development Services.

□ Who do I contact with Questions or concerns.

□ What is considered a New Establishment?

- A new or remodeled establishment or a change of ownership of an existing establishment or an establishment which has been closed for six months or more.
