Approved traffic control needed prior to the start of any work. Contact field inspection office 740-2650.

Work over 1000 feet requires Cultural Resource Approval prior to permit submittal and review.

Any native plant disturbance will require a Native Plant review prior to permit issuance.

All wireless communication facilities require the establishment of a license agreement.

Work of 201 feet or more requires photos and a plan review prior to permit issuance.

Coordinate all work with the field inspector prior to starting any work.

Minimum 36" depth for all utilities in Pima County Right-Of-Way.

All disturbed areas shall be restored to their original condition.

Minimum 8' off edge of pavement for all utility poles.

Minimum 5' depth for utilities in wash areas.

Permit can be renewed once for a fee of \$25.00.
